NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Entries close at 6:00 p.m., **Wednesday, March 7, 2012** at the Trial Secretary's home (after which time, entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, or substituted, except as provided for Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules, or when entry limits have been reached.

Make checks or money orders payable to **PVSSC**. All fees are payable in U.S. funds.

Fax, email, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable. Do not send entries requiring a signature upon delivery. Returned checks, postdated checks or declined credit cards do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Trial Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

UDX Entries: Please check the box on the Obedience Entry form for UDX. Dogs entered in this class will be entered in both Utility B and Open B.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made. No refunds will be made after the closing date for the trial.

Declination of entries: The PVSSC may decline any entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall claim or recourse against the PVSSC or any official thereof.

The facility will open at 7:30 a.m. on Saturday and Sunday. There is plenty of room for crates.

Multiple Venues: Every effort will be made to assist exhibitors competing in multiple venues as long as it does not impact the other exhibitors. Judges may change the running order to facilitate the smooth running of the Trials.

Jump Order: Jump order is stated on Page 4. PVSSC will accommodate handlers with multiple entries in the same class and jump height.

All dogs not being worked must be kept quiet, on leash and away from the rings. Please keep persons and dogs at least five feet (5') from ring. This is to minimize distractions from the dog performing in the ring.

Please keep noises down and refrain from clapping unless all rings have stopped trialing. Clapping and hoots create distracters for dogs competing.

As you enter the facility pick up your Welcome Envelope. The envelope will include your arm band and other information. Please "**check-in**" by checking off next to your number. If you have any entered dogs that are absent, please write ABS next to your number.

Move ups will be permitted. The request for a move-up must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary, Virginia Torsch at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial. Move-ups may be approved, provided the next level class (i.e. Novice to Advanced) and judge is available and the class has not reached its limit. Forms are on pages 8 and 9 and will be available on the "welcome" table in the lobby the day of the trials.

FOOD will be available for purchase on site.

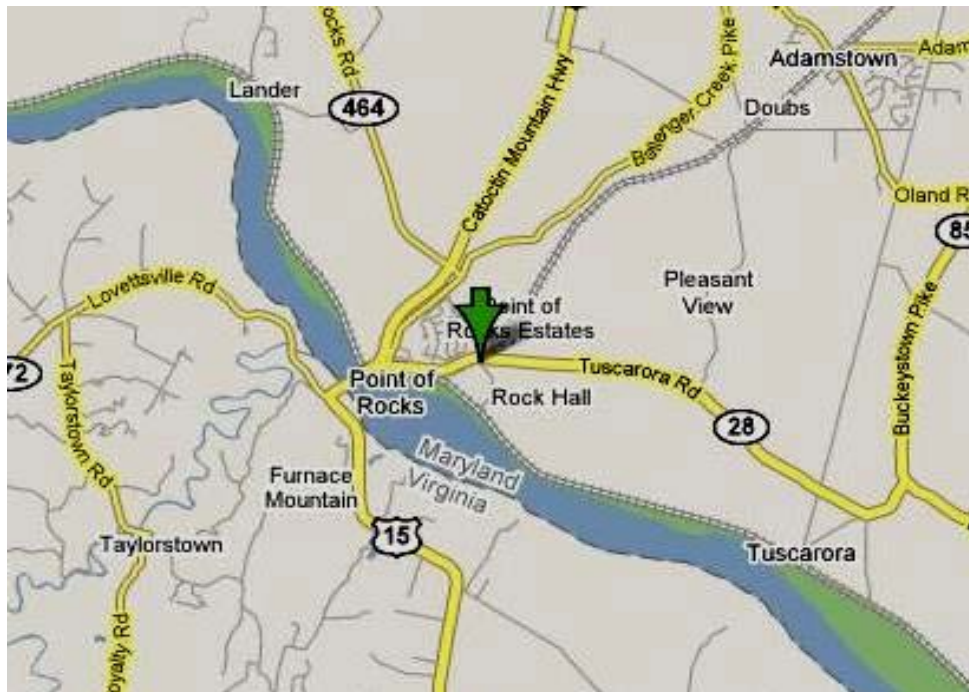
DIRECTIONS

The site is 12 miles SW of Frederick, MD and 13 miles north of Leesburg, VA

Directions: From the North (I-70): take US Rt 340 & 15 South from Frederick towards Leesburg & Harpers Ferry; take US 15 South to Point Of Rocks/MD Rt 28 (flashing yellow light immediately before Potomac River Bridge); turn left onto MD- 28 and go approximately 1 mile and turn right onto Rock Hall Rd. (immediately after RR); site is one story building on left.

Directions: From Washington I-270: follow signs for Rt 340 to Rt 15 South and follow as above.

Directions: From South and Southwest: Take Rt. 15 North to cross the Potomac River at Point of Rocks, turning right on MD-28. Go approximately 1 mile and turn right onto Rock Hall Rd. (immediately after RR); site is one story building on left.
