 - ▶ Make checks or money orders payable to **Potomac Valley Shetland Sheepdog Club or (PVSSC)**. All fees are payable in U.S. funds.

 - ▶ Fax, email, telephone and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on an official entry form and photocopies of entry forms without agreement and rules are NOT ACCEPTABLE. Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgement of entries will be made as soon as practicable. Do not send entries requiring a signature upon delivery. Returned checks or postdated checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Test/Trial Secretary will add a \$30 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.
 - ▶ **PLEASE make your entries correct and legible.** Illegible entries cannot be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Owner/Exhibitors are responsible for errors on entry forms. (Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 6).
 - ▶ Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused by the Judge or Veterinarian, or barred from competition by action of the Show Committee. No refunds for bitches in season. If because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the show giving club, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refunds will be made. No refunds will be made after the closing date for the trial.
 - ▶ Bitches in season shall be eligible and will run at the end of the class in tests, and in catalog order as listed in the class in trials.
 - ▶ **Food** will be available at show site. Please dispose of trash in the proper manner.
 - ▶ All dogs present which are not being worked in the arena must be kept quiet, off course, on leash and away from the fences. Please do not allow them to disturb the resting stock or interfere with the working dogs.
 - ▶ Declination of entries: The PVSSC may decline any entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall claim or recourse against the PVSSC or any official thereof.
 - ▶ Judges are not required to wait for dogs. It is the responsibility of the owner/handler to have the dog at ringside when required and without being called. Judges may change the running order to facilitate the smooth running of the Test/Trial.
 - ▶ Bring appropriate weather clothing and equipment. The weather is unpredictable at this time of the year. The Event will be held rain, snow, or shine. Sunrise is at 6:53 am and sets at 4:58 pm. Normal morning temperature is: 40 degrees for November.
 - ▶ AKC Herding Rules & Regulations, Section 13: Closing of Entries/Alternates and Move-Ups
- Whenever test or trial entry limits have been reached all additional entries that are received prior to the closing date shall be added to an alternate's list for each level that exceeds the published limit(s).
Entrants on the alternates list must check in with the Herding Secretary on the grounds no later than 30 minutes before the commencement of their class.
Requests to move-up must be given to the Herding Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the event.

From I-66: Take Route 17 South (Exit 28). Proceed south on route 17 turn Left on Elk Run Road (4.7 Miles), turn right on Midland Road(4.4 Miles), turn right on Bristerburg Road (.3 Miles) and right on Blackwells Mill Road (1.7 Miles). 12832 is on the right at a black mailbox.

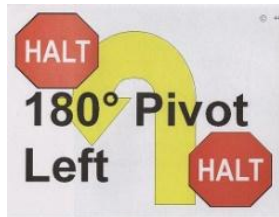
